

Comments

This chart should be read in conjunction with the accompanying book, "The Rise of the Cubs," by Branson Hopkins. Both the book and this chart are copyright to Branson Hopkins, 1997. This chart has been produced specifically with the activities and involvements of Dr John Thomas (founder of Christadelphians) in the fore. He migrated to America in 1852 and became active in the religious development of the eastern states at a time when the predictions of a Baptist pastor William Miller, foretelling that Jesus would return between 1843 and 1844, were gaining ground. Simultaneously another religious movement, referred to as the "Reformation" was attracting followers. This was the work of Thomas Campbell which led to the formation of The Disciples.

The results today of William Miller's erroneous prediction and Dr Thomas' doctrines are apparent in the overall message of this chart, though the detail is by no means exhaustive.

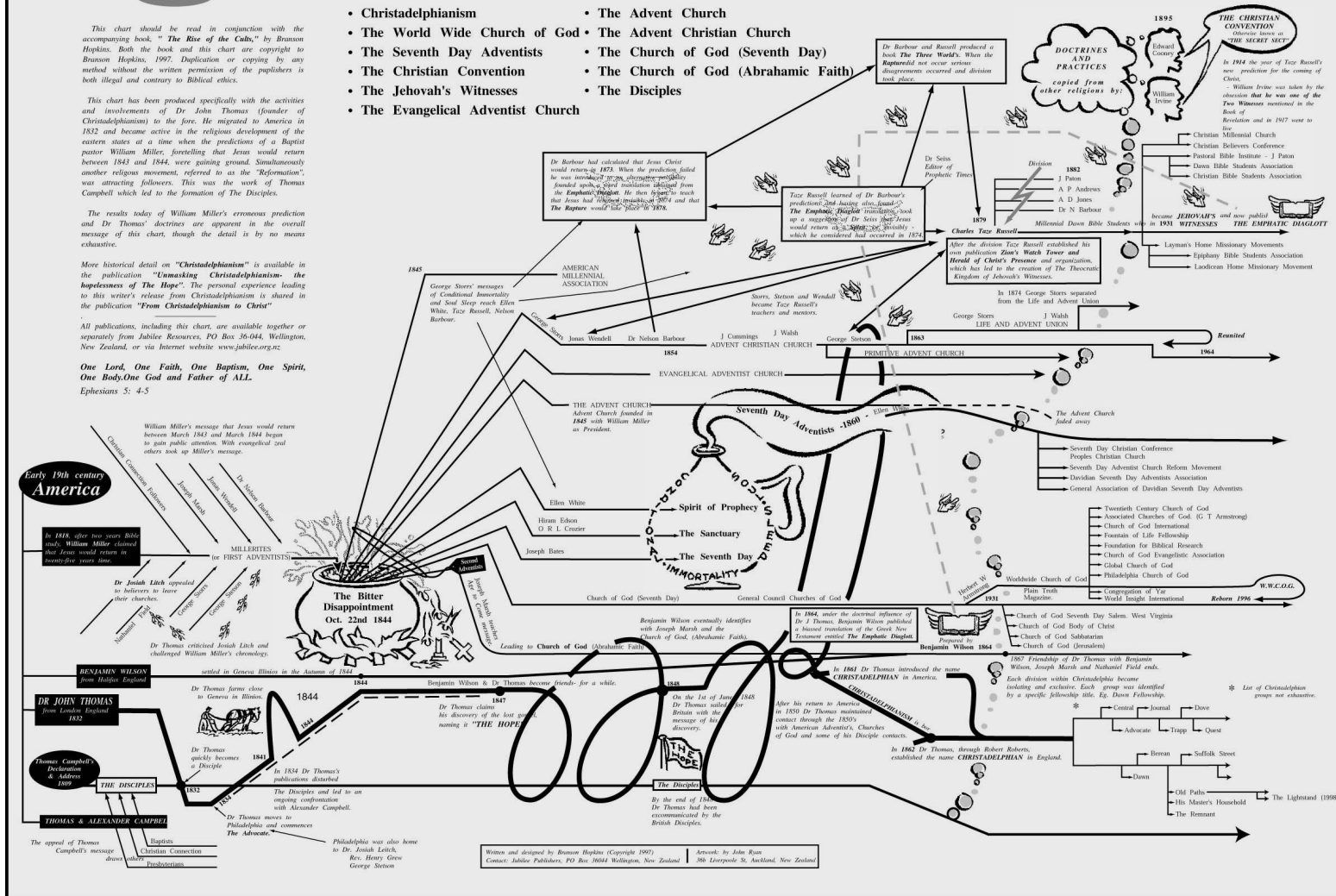
